The Sibling Support Group at The Children's Institute of Pittsburgh

The Sibling Support Group at The Children's Institute is **open to children ages 11-14 who have a sibling with a disability.**

The group will meet weekly for six weeks and will include interactive sessions designed to offer peer support and develop improved coping skills and well-being.

Please note that programming is targeted toward cognitively typical 11-14 year olds.

Registration

Referrals are currently being accepted. Please email Dr. Becky Keenan (rek@the-institute.org) and Dr. Rachael Hoffman (rhx@the-institute.org) with your child's **name**, **date of birth**, and the best **phone number** to reach you. The authorizations department at The Children's Institute will then contact you to confirm insurance coverage. Once authorization is obtained, an initial intake appointment with you and your child will be scheduled to gain an understanding of your child's needs and to determine whether the sibling group will be a good fit for him or her.
