At The Children's Institute of Pittsburgh, we provide a continuum of clinical, educational and social services that meet the needs of the children we serve. After identifying a growing necessity for accessible behavioral health services for children and youth with special health care needs, The Children's Institute is now providing such services on an outpatient basis. Children and families who are already receiving services for chronic pain, concussion management or acquired brain injury may receive our outpatient behavioral health services at this time.

Services occur along with continuous communication among all medical management, rehabilitation, education and social services providers.
