## Brain Blood Flow and EEG Biofeedback for ADHD

Biofeedback has been shown to be a safe and non-invasive treatment for children with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). During biofeedback sessions your child's brain will be trained through fun, computerized programs to increase the ability to focus.

The ideal candidate is between the ages of 8-18 and has a diagnosis of ADHD-Inattentive type. This treatment is not recommended for those with seizure disorders or possible bipolar disorder.

### **Brain Blood Flow Biofeedback**

- Measures and increases the blood flow to the frontal lobes of the brain.

### **EEG Biofeedback**

- Measures brain electrical activity and trains the brain to inhibit slow waves that impede attention and improve faster waves that promote attention.
